
RE: 2006/42/CE MACHINE DIRECTIVE AND 2014-68-UE PRESSURE EQUIPMENT DIRECTIVE APPLICABILITY

The writing company,

as the only responsible part, according to the European directives mentioned,

DECLARES that

regarding the products in its catalog,

1) 2006/42/CE Machine Directive

Referring to the emission of 2006/42/CE Machine Directive, Enerfluid studied the applicability of rules referred to its product range. The results are, (as per the guide lines of Machine work team, named by the European Commission, par. 35):
“Machine Directive is not applied directly to the machine components, as:

- oil/hydraulic cylinders, - pressure intensifiers, - valves etc.

when they are not specifically applied such and they are incorporated into machines, even if the planning and the building of those components have to be made in way to realize the complete machine in conformity to the relevant basic safety and health requirements.”

THEREFORE

ENERFLUID products as pressure multipliers, hydraulic cylinders and valves, are EXCLUDED from the application of Machine Directive

2) 2014-68-UE Pressure Equipment Directive

Pressure multipliers, hydraulic locking cylinders, power units, hydraulic speed regulators

are excluded from the field of application of 2014-68-UE Pressure Equipment Directive, as per article 1, point 2.

THEREFORE

Products ENERFLUID are excluded from the modules of PED Directive and they are classified into “SOUND ENGINEERING PRACTICE category” for DESIGN AND MANUFACTURING.

These equipments have not to refer to CE marking, as per the article 18.
